Katherine Dunn's prize-winning boxing journalism has appeared in many publications, from *The Ring* and *KO Magazine* to *Vogue* and *Playboy*. She is currently an associate editor of cyberboxingzone.com. Dunn's novel *Geek Love* was a 1989 National Book Award finalist; her latest book is *One-Ring Circus: Dispatches from the World of Boxing*.

Geoff Dyer is the author of several fiction and nonfiction books, including *But Beautiful*, which was awarded the Somerset Maugham Prize, and *Out of Sheer Rage*, a National Book Critics Circle finalist. His latest novel is *Jeff in Venice*, *Death in Varanasi*. He lives in London.
