And no doubt the Ogre of fairy tales, the Oreo of the Italians, are varieties of the terrible (Egir. The root of his name is, in fact, og or uok, the same as our awe. Thence Yggr is a title of Odin, and the great world tree was called Yggdrasil, from ygg, and drisall, a horse or bearer, because of Odin's having hung upon it. Thence com...
